## What is an APS Allowance?

When an ISA investor dies, their surviving spouse or civil partner is entitled to make use of the APS allowance in addition to their personal annual ISA allowance.

The subscriptions you can make will be the higher value of the deceased's ISA(s) as at their date of death, or at the point of closure. The closing balance will usually be higher as we continue to pay tax-free interest into the ISA(s). You may wish to wait until the deceased's ISA is closed before requesting the APS valuation or taking any action to use the APS allowance.
